DAY 1 Welcome to Banff

After your arrival in Calgary, you'll be transferred to your hotel in the heart of Banff National Park. Settle into Canada's 'Castle in the Rockies,' perhaps indulging in a treatment at the spa or popping into the Ramsay Bar for a welcoming cocktail. Tonight, gather for a dinner tasting exquisite local specialties on your culinary journey through a selection of the hotel's finest restaurants to begin your luxury tour of Canada.

DAY 2 Banff at Leisure

Greet the day soaring high above the Rockies on an optional helicopter flight. Personalize your afternoon taking the Banff Gondola to the top of Sulphur Mountain for a bird's eye view of six mountain ranges of the Canadian Rockies. You'll climb 7,486 feet to the Summit Upper Terminal where you'll be greeted with breathtaking views in every direction. You can even enjoy a self-guided interpretive walk along the summit ridge on the Banff Skyway. Or, tee up at the stunning and world-renowned Banff Springs Golf Course – recognized repeatedly as the best golf course in Canada – to play nine holes of golf with epic scenery stretching out in every direction. Seek out the utmost in relaxation unwinding to the calming sounds of rushing waterfalls and burbling mineral pools at the Willow Stream Mineral Pools and Spa.

OPTIONAL EXPERIENCES:

Mt. Assiniboine Helicopter Tour (35 min) - It's one blockbuster after another zipping in a helicopter to Mount Assiniboine - "the Matterhorn" of the Canadian Rockies. Get your camera ready to snap one pic after the next of this photogenic peak rising to 11,870 feet along the Great Divide. And just when you think you've seen it all, the Gloria and Assiniboine Glaciers will make your jaw drop.

Three Sisters Peaks Tour (25 min) - Gear up for the most action packed twenty minutes of your life. You won't want to miss your chance fly past famous Three Sisters Peaks. Get up close to the peaks before escaping into the Spray Valley where you will explore the wild colours of the Spray Lakes. Return along the Goat Range before following the pristine Bow River back to Canmore.

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DAY 3 Lakes of Banff National Park



In season, visit Moraine Lake to bask in the natural beauty of this azure-coloured lake tucked beneath 10 towering peaks – each over 9,800 feet high – in the Valley of the Ten Peaks and the Wenkchemna Glacier. Get acquainted with your new picturesque settings as you check into the Fairmont Château on Lake Louise boasting views of the glistening emerald lake and Victoria Glacier. Dinner tonight is your choice of the hotel's many options including Swiss fondue in an upscale pub.

DAY 4 Along the Icefields Parkway to Jasper

Travel the Icefields Parkway alongside the rugged Rockies landscape to welcome your day of adventure and native culture. Hop on a specially designed Ice Explorer traversing the surface of the Athabasca Glacier, part of the Columbia Icefield, before putting feet to ground on this remarkable landscape dusted with frosty snow. Meet the First Nations Warrior Women, who are matriarchs of the Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation and guardians of their culture, for a special barbecue dinner on Trefoil Lake with spectacular views of Pyramid Mountain. Engage in conversation about Indigenous culture, storytelling and drumming. Learn songs, beautiful phrases in Cree and gain a deeper understanding of the First Nations' spirituality.

DAY 5 Jasper National Park



Glide across the crystal waters of magical, glacier fed Maligne Lake past mountain peaks to Spirit Island, a remote destination only accessible by boat (seasonal). Or, pedal your way on the scenic trails of UNESCO World Heritage Site Jasper National Park to take in sights only visible from these winding paths. Journey to Maligne Canyon, the deepest canyon in the park for a walk on several of the scenic bridges crossing bubbling streams. Unwind this evening in your lodge where you'll be surrounded by nature and abundant wildlife on this 700-acre luxury mountain resort on the shores of pristine Lac Beauvert.

DAY 6 Jasper to Kamloops
