

DAY 1 Welcome to Energetic Belfast

DAY 2 Highlights of Belfast

DAY 3 Giant's Causeway and Londonderry



Venture north to experience Northern Ireland's rugged coastal scenery at the Giant's Causeway. DAY 5 A Truly Irish Experience

DAY 6 Glendalough to Kilkenny
